Since its founding in 1970, the Pelham Art Center faculty has grown as the Center has extended its reach to offer more courses to students of all ages. More than 1,300 students attended over 100 visual art classes and workshops offered at the Art Center from 2009 to present day. These classes were taught by more than 20 art educators, many of whom are participating in this exhibition alongside their students. This exhibit is on view from July 9 – August 15. The **Opening Reception** will take place on Friday, July 9 from 6:30-8:00 p.m. This event is free and open to the public.

During the opening, visitors and prospective students of all ages may participate in a free **All Age Art Workshop** held in the studios. In addition, the public is invited to meet the teaching artists and PAC staff, discuss course offerings with them and see their varied and accomplished artworks.
