GUIDELINES FOR CURATORIAL PROPOSALS

Pelham Art Center welcomes proposals from curators who wish to curate group exhibition programs of artworks including painting, drawing, ceramics, sculpture, print making, fiber arts, film, video and sound art, photography, installation art, and contemporary crafts. Group exhibitions usually feature between eight and twelve artists who fall under a thematic umbrella that is conceptually relevant.

Pelham Art Center hosts six or seven art exhibitions each year of works by local, national, and international artists. The gallery program features free admission and public openings with All-Age Art Workshops. During the course of the exhibition, the Art Center may host ArtTalk lectures or other related programming. Exhibitions are planned through the collaborative efforts of independent curators, Pelham Art Center staff, and a twelve-member volunteer Gallery Advisory Committee.

We encourage potential applicants not familiar with Pelham Art Center's exhibition program or our physical venue to visit the Art Center for a tour to better envision the gallery's capacity.

What Pelham Art Center Provides

Pelham Art Center will host selected exhibitions for a period of seven weeks; coordinate the receipt of shipped artworks and artist texts with the curator and artists; insure the artwork while on site; promote the exhibition; install/de-install; document, present, and archive exhibition on Pelham Art Center's website; coordinate the educational programming with the curator; and provide an honorarium to guest lecturers in connection with our public programs when and where funding permits. Pelham Art Center does not pay for shipping of artwork.

What to Include in Your Proposal

Please send a one-page proposal description of the exhibition, accompanied with names, contact information, and bios of artists, as well as visual examples of works being considered and curator's resume. All files should be submitted digitally on a disc or as a ZIP file via web download. Images should be jpegs, 300 dpi at 4" x 5".
